## Establishment

---

Keep seedbed moist to enhance germination. Under ideal conditions, germination should begin within 10 to 12 days and be complete within 21 days. The stand will be fully established in 35 days. After establishment, a deep watering program is recommended to improve root depth. Irrigate according to turfgrass needs for your geographical area.

Mow 1/2 to 2 1/2 inches, depending on use. Ideally maintain at 1 to 2-inch mowing height. Do not remove more than 1/3 of total plant height with each mowing.
