Management Keys

PayDay readily establishes on loosened bare soil or in close cut harvested fields for cover crop use. For typical new seeding applications apply at a rate of 20-25 lbs. per acre. For overseeding and cover crop use seed at a rate of 10-15 lbs. per acre for pastures and 3-5 lbs. per acre into thinning alfalfa stands. Use a Brillion seeder, a no-till drill or broadcast followed by a culti-packer. Seed to soil contact is critical to successful germination and establishment. For highest quality hay harvest at first boot stage.
